### Up & Coming Runs & Events:

1. Ellerslie Car Show – 12<sup>th</sup> Feb. 6-slots available for display vehicles. To be attended by Graeme W, Mark, Amber, Jake, David, Brett W. Theme will be 'World of Wheels'. Looking to produce a LR brochure such as a 1-pg flyer + take the LROCA display fags etc.

### NZ4WDA:

A North Zone Zoom call was held with 9 attending therefore no quorum.

Maratoto (the Wires), DOC sent information to the association regarding compliance requirements for H&S and Kauri dieback when accessing the track. The main DOC representative for this area, Peter French passed away recently; he was an pleasant and helpful representative, easy to deal with and will be

missed. Another local representative closed the track when there were vehicles (4 trucks) in and (4 trucks) out. This resulted in willful damage to the gate in an attempt to exit having been locked in. The local council are considering closure of another 4wd track nearby.

42 Traverse is closed due to a slip.

Muriwai – Auckland Parks Committee are proposing a gate to be installed at rate payers' expense and a cost of c\$500k + consent fees etc. Muriwai Beach Access Committee (Johnny Wheeler & Co.) are proposing obtaining a legal opinion whether Auckland Council have the necessary jurisdiction to undertake the closure of the beach access on Coast Road. Cost is estimated at \$3500-5500 plus GST. Question posed – would LROCA consider contributing to obtaining this legal opinion along with other clubs on the basis that this could form an important precedent in potentially dissuading other Councils from following suit. Potentially NZDFWDA could facilitate the bank account for accumulation of club contributions. Show of hands indicated a majority in favor (>90%) of the proposal.

Other Business:

Question posed should the club print new business cards to be available at events & displays etc. Consensus yes.

Meeting concluded with a round-the-room of persons happenings with LR's over the prior month.
